# **Examples of Theory of Mind Development**

### Mental/Physical Distinction

• I am thinking of dog. Can I pet the dog I am thinking about?

## Appearance/Reality Judgments

• knowing between a shoe and a rock painted to look like a shoe

#### **Diverse Desires**

- different people have different feelings about an object
- Mommy likes carrots, but I do not like them.

#### **Diverse Beliefs**

- different people can believe different things about the same object
- Mommy thinks there are more cookies, but I think the cookies are gone.

#### False Beliefs

- people can believe things even if they are not true
- Mommy thinks there are more cookies, but I know there are not anymore, because I ate the last one.

# Predicting what another person thinks that another person thinks

- She thought that Mandy would think that dress was too long
- He thought she wouldn't like the taste of the spicy pizza

## Believing what another person feels/believes

- He knew she would not be happy to find the vase broken
- She thought he would think the dog was actually gone

## Intending that another person believe/feel

- He did not want to her to know the surprise, so he said he had forgotten her gift
- He didn't want to mom to get mad so he told her that he had finished his homework, but he still had more to do
